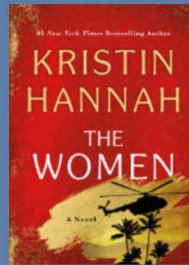

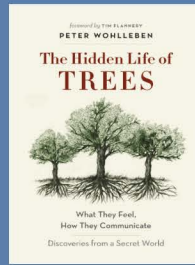
Most borrowed fiction book



Most borrowed nonfiction book



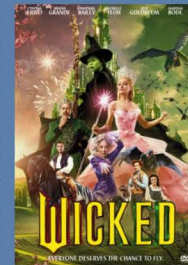
Most borrowed fiction ebook/audiobook

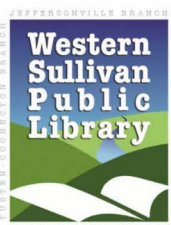
