HOMEBOUND PATRONS

Any resident of the Sullivan West Central School District unable to come to the Library because of limited mobility, illness, or handicap, is eligible for a homebound library card from Western Sullivan Public Library.

Residents interested in homebound delivery will be asked to complete an application for a library card and a questionnaire. Once eligibility is established, the patron will be able to telephone the library and request materials. To identify homebound patrons, enter the patron's telephone number in the computer as follows: h845-555-5555. The PTYPE for the patron will be designated "Outreach" (SP).

Materials may be delivered to the homebound patron, unless other arrangements have been made. Staff members or trustees, upon approval by the director, may deliver materials to homebound patrons at their convenience. Mileage reimbursement will be paid upon completion of WSPL's Mileage Record.

The loan period for materials sent to the homebound patron, with the exception of entertainment videos and new books, may be extended to a 21 day loan.

Homebound patrons will be responsible for any overdue fines and/or damaged or lost fees.
